



## On-Campus Code of Conduct

Before On-Campus registration is complete, students and parents/guardians are required to read and agree to the Code to Success On-Campus Code of Conduct. Students registered for Code to Success will comply with the Code of Conduct. If the Code of Conduct is violated three times curriculum access will be revoked and the student will be instructed to leave the On-Campus program.

Code of Conduct violations include, but are not limited to:

- Posts that contain spam, inappropriate comments, and/or inappropriate images and content on the Bottega Support channels
- Watching YouTube videos/playing games outside of designated breaks
- Sleeping during class
- Failure to follow campus rules designated by the facilitating teacher
- Failure to show or withholding progress on curriculum and projects from facilitating teachers and mentors
- Missing more than three days without notifying the facilitating teacher at your campus
- Clicking “mark complete” without engaging with the curriculum

Below are the consequences for Code of Conduct violations:

- *First Violation:* Verbal warning to student
- *Second Violation:* Parent/guardian will be notified
- *Third Violation:* Curriculum access will be revoked, and the student will be instructed to leave the program

There is a “**Zero-tolerance**” policy for bullying, whether Online or In-Person. Therefore, any students who participate in bullying will have curriculum access revoked, parents/guardians will be notified, and students will be instructed to leave the program immediately.
